Please ensure your child is in full uniform for arrival. **If you are missing uniform items, we have lots of items in stock in the Plast Toronto Tuck Shop at the Huculak Centre. Please email Myosia <marpha25@gmail.com> WELL IN ADVANCE of camp to arrange to pick up your items, as the store is not permanently staffed.**

Head Lice Check

Every year we require a head lice check before camp. If this is not done your child will NOT be allowed to come to camp. We will not be checking on the day of registration given current drop-off plans.

There are 2 options for parents:

Option 1

Bring your child to the Plast Huculak Centre on one of the following dates:

Date: **June 30**

Time: 8:00pm – 9:00pm.

Date: **July 1**

Time: 9:00am – 11:00am

We will have volunteers on hand to do checks.

Option 2

Have your child checked by a certified lice removal professional. You will need to present a certificate and the check will need to occur no earlier than 3 days before camp.

Mail

Kids really enjoy getting mail. We strongly encourage you to mail letters a week before camp starts to ensure the letters arrive on time.

Packages - it is best not to send packages to your child. Packages can cause tensions among the campers as others may not receive a package.

We can only accept mail from Canada Post.

Medical Details

Parents will be able to speak to and consult with the camp First Aid Attendant on Sunday July 3rd. If you are dropping off any medication for your child to take during camp we require detailed written instructions to be provided to the First Aid Attendant at drop off.

Ticks

Please be aware that there are ticks in the Grafton area.

We will undertake daily tick checks.

If a tick is found it will be removed only by the First Aid Attendant.

What to pack?

Please refer to the [camp handbook](#), specifically page 13.

It is imperative that each child has everything labelled with their names.

Please do not forget the following items in particular:

- water bottle
- hat
- rubber boots
- closed toed running shoes
- disposable masks (15 - 20)

Unpacking

Campers will be unpacking and setting up their bunks without parental involvement. This is a camp tradition and provides the campers with a sense of personal accomplishment. They will receive step-by-step instructions from the camp counsellors and leaders all of whom will be available to help the kids with whatever they need. It is a fun bonding experience with their peers.

Covid Protocols

Here is the current plan for camp arrival:

Morning drop-off at camp will occur in Grafton on the field outside of camp. Everyone in the car should be wearing masks when you arrive to talk to the registration team. Only exit the vehicle when asked by the counsellors.

Upon arrival at Camp, every child will be tested for Covid onsite. Once the child receives a negative covid test result they will be directed to the camp registration desk. You will sign in your child, review any details and may drop off any letters you would like to leave for them. The camp Counsellors will help the kids carry the luggage into camp. Parents will not be allowed into the camp or cabins during either drop off or pick up.

Campers will remain in cohorts for the first 72 hours. After 72 hours, all campers will be tested for Covid a second time. Once everyone has a negative covid test result we will begin mixing cohorts so the kids can truly have a fun and magical camp experience together as one group.

Masks will be worn in the following situations:

- At registration
- When visiting the First Aid Attendant
- If anyone tests positive for Covid

We suggest testing your child in the morning prior to driving to camp. Each camper will be tested in Grafton regardless of whether you tested them at home but, should your child test positive at home, please do not drive up to camp. Anyone who tests positive for Covid at drop off will not be admitted to camp.
